*Special notes for students, teachers or parents:

1. This song is arranged for playing in the **Middle C position**, i.e. LH: F G A B C; RH: C D E F G
2. The note "A" in right hand part in Bar 18 is not part of the Middle C position. Students can play this note by reaching the 5th finger one key to the right.
3. Teachers or parents can accompany the student's playing using the chord symbols written above the bars.
4. As this is a simplified version for beginners, only crotchets, minims and semibreves are used. To simplify the counting process, a *fermata* (pause) is used at the end of each phrase instead of long tied notes. Please guide students about the length of the pauses to best match the original song.
